Dotori's Korean program is built on three pillars—Learning in Context, Language Connection, and Joyful Learning—designed to help students build meaningful communication skills through engaging, culturally rich experiences.



LEARNING IN CONTEXT

Learn Korean through real-life topics, stories, and cultural contexts that make language use authentic and meaningful.



LANGUAGE CONNECTION

Explore links between English and Korean to deepen understanding, transfer skills, and strengthen bilingual competence.



JOYFUL LEARNING

Engage in fun, interestbased activities—such as games, songs, and projects—that connect to students' own lives and Korean culture.

KOREAN LANGUAGE PROGRAM OPTIONS

Hangul

- K-2 students only
- Focus: Korean Phonics-Mastering basic consonants
- 15 weeks (1 class/week)
- 90-minute lessons
- Weekly homework
- End-of-course parent conference with teacher

K-Book Club

- Grades 3–5, advanced Korean learners only
- Focus: Reading and writing in Korean, engaging in discussions, and completing projects
- 10 weeks (1 class/week)
- 60-minute lessons
- End-of-course parent conference with teacher

Speaking

- Gr.3-5 students only
- 10 weeks (1 class/week)
- 60-min lesson
- Target to learn conversational Korean through fun media (movies, K-pop, K-drama etc.)
- Weekly Homework
- End-of-Course Parent Conference w/ Teacher
