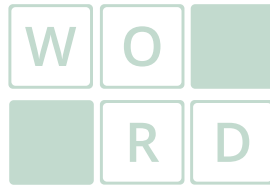
OUR **WRITING** PROGRAM'S CORE PILLARS

Dotori's writing program is built on three pillars—Background Knowledge, Vocabulary, and Language Function—developed through rich reading and engaging activities.



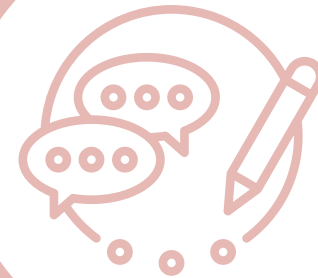
BACKGROUND KNOWLEDGE
